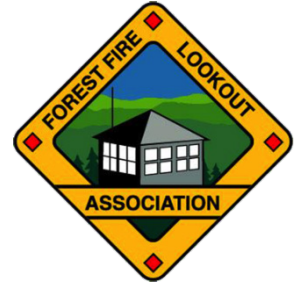

ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR 2018:

- Continued outreach and coordination with approximately the 11 states with the highest number of lookouts. This includes, Washington, Oregon, California, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Arizona, New Mexico, Minnesota, Florida, and Pennsylvania. As of June and July, no new Section 106 consultations had been requested by federal agencies. This coordination will continue in 2019 as there are several projects in California for the Forest Service that are expected to come up.
- We continue to work on the coordination between FFLA, Wyoming SHPO, and Yellowstone National Park on the Mount Washburn cellular antennae project. As of last report, construction had begun by the time the lookout came down and it appear the structure was going to clear the new equipment above the field of vision for whomever is staffing the lookout. Still waiting for official confirmation on what rehabilitation plans were finalized with the contractor.
- Working with Wisconsin SHPO to list as many remaining state DNR lookouts as possible. There was a huge effort by Tyler Bormann and two other volunteers to complete state listing forms for the standing towers. His report presumably shares more details. I have still been trying to get a hold of the WI-SHPO contact to see if he received Tyler's information.
- Assisted local and state chapter directors with SHPO questions.
